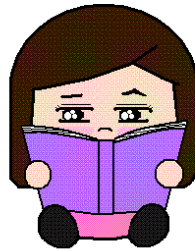

Our vendors require the lunch order to be submitted with ample notice. This is why we require orders to be submitted the week prior to consumption.

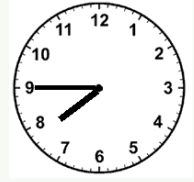
Payment is due with the order form.

Please remember, we are working up until the very last minute of each day. Early pick ups disrupt the flow of instruction.

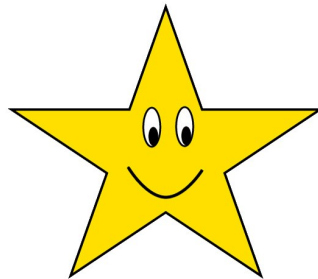
